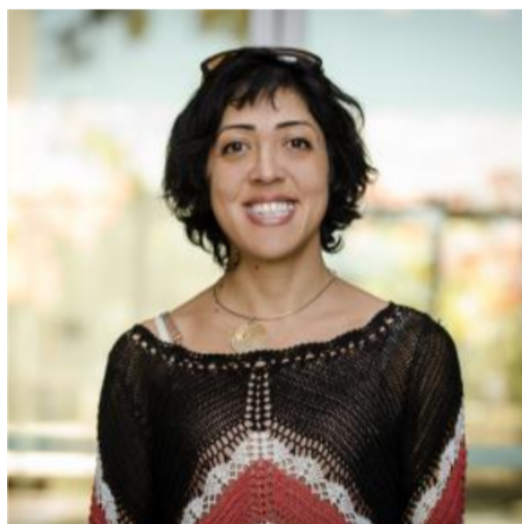
Using Personal Data to Predict Blood Pressure
